

CSD RESOLUTION NO. 2007-25

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CAMARILLO SANITARY DISTRICT ADOPTING A SCHEDULE OF FEES FOR THE ISSUANCE OF GREASE INTERCEPTORS PERMITS AND HOLDING APPEALS OF ADMINISTRATIVE DECISIONS UNDER THE DISTRICT'S OPERATIONS CODE

The Board of Directors of the Camarillo Sanitary District resolves as follows:

SECTION 1. Findings. The Board of Directors of the Camarillo Sanitary District finds as follows:

- A. Pursuant to CSD Ordinance No. 78, the District has adopted a permitting procedure in Chapter 6 of the District's Operations Code for interceptors to capture fats, oils and grease (FOG) in order to prevent such substances from being released into the District's sewer system by designated food service facilities.
- B. Pursuant to CSD Ordinance No. 79, the District has adopted an appeals procedure in Chapter 1 of the District's Operations Code to provide for appeals of administrative decisions.
- C. It is necessary to establish a fee for such permits and appeals in order to offset a portion of the costs the District incurs when it provides services related to such procedures.
- D. As set forth in the accompanying staff report, which is incorporated by reference, the fees established by this resolution are less than the estimated reasonable costs of providing the services for which the fees are charged.

SECTION 2. Adoption of Fees. The Board of Directors of the Camarillo Sanitary District adopts the following fees:

- A. \$300 for filing an appeal under Section 1010 of Chapter 1 of the Operations Code.
- B. \$100 for filing an application for a FOG permit under Section 6022 of Chapter 6 of the Operations Code.

SECTION 3. Effective Date. These fees will be effective upon adoption of this CSD Resolution.


SECTION 4. Certification of Resolution. The District's Assistant Secretary is directed to certify the adoption of this CSD Resolution.
